Criteria for Weaning Safety 1 Swallowing function: If the swallowing function is not safe, there is a major risk of aspiration of food and liquids 2 Medical condition: The medical condition conflicts with fasting, oral feeding, or would allow the child only to eat unpalatable nutrition and a body mass index (BMI) below the 10th percentile 3

Wean when forage will no longer support lactating cow Traditional 6-8 months Less stressful to calf More marketable at weaning Fewer days on feed to finish and lower input cost Early 3-5 months Conserve forage and cow condition under drought Accelerate finish timing (-30 days) Possible greater marbling and better

Weaning of Medications 1 If on a scheduled dose of morphine, begin weaning morphine by 10% of the highest "stabilizing" dose, examples listed below 2 Weaning should occur as frequently as tolerated and can occur as often as 3 times per day (every 8 hours) If supportive care is increased, pharmacologic care can often be decreased rapidly 3

Improving ewe nutrition for Better Returns

Before feed reaches the rumen, breakdown has started by the initial chewing process Rumination (or chewing the cud) returns the feed to the mouth for further chewing This is often done when the ewes are lying down fibre content of the diet; the more fibre there is, the longer the ewe will ruminate This process breaks the feed down into
